



Cookie Policy

INFORMATION

In compliance with the Law of Services of the Information and Electronic Commerce Society and the current legislation included in Organic Law 34/2002, of 11th July, modified in the art. 22 for art. 4.3 contained in Title II, modifications related to the transposition of Directives in the area of Telecommunications and Information Society, of Royal Decree Law 13/2012, of 30th March through which directives on electronic communications are transposed, we inform you of the use of cookies on the company website in order to facilitate and improve navigation.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small data files that are created in the user's device (computer, tablet, mobile phone etc.) on entering a website or application. Cookies allow, among other things, to collect statistical information, provide certain technical features, store and retrieve information about the browsing habits or preferences of a user or their team and, depending on the information they contain and the way in which they use your device, they can be used to recognise the user. Bear in mind that cookies cannot damage your computer and that, in turn, if they are activated they help us to identify and resolve possible errors.

COOKIES USED ON OUR WEBSITE

Our website uses its own and third-party cookies to offer you a better experience and service. When browsing or using our services, the user accepts our use of cookies. However, the user has the option to prevent the generation of cookies and the elimination of cookies by selecting the corresponding option in their browser. However, if the use of cookies is blocked in your browser it is possible that some services or features of the website will not be available.

COOKIES AFFECTED BY THE REGULATIONS AND EXCEPTED COOKIES

According to the EU directive, the cookies that require the informed consent of the user are analytical cookies and those for advertising and affiliation, excepting those of a technical nature and those necessary for the operation of the website or the provision of services expressly requested by the user.

WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES ARE THERE?

ACCORDING TO THE PURPOSE

Technical and functional cookies: those that allow the user to navigate through a web page, platform or application and use the different options or services that exist in it, such as controlling traffic and data communication, identifying the session, accessing restricted access parts, remembering the elements of an order, carrying out the purchase process of an order, registering or participating in an event, using security elements while browsing, storing content to broadcast videos or sound or share content through social networks. They include personalization cookies, which are those that allow the user to access the service with some predefined general characteristics based on a series of criteria in the user's terminal, such as the language, the type of browser, the regional configuration from where you access the service, etc.



Analytical cookies: those that allow the person responsible for them to monitor and analyse the behaviour of the users of the websites to which they are linked. The information collected through this type of cookies is used to measure the activity of the websites, application or platform and for the elaboration of navigation profiles of the users of said sites, applications and platforms, in order to introduce improvements in function of the analysis of the usage data made by the users of the service.

Advertising cookies: those that allow the most efficient management possible of the advertising spaces that, where appropriate, the editor has included in a web page, application or platform from which the requested service is provided based on criteria such as edited content or how often ads are shown.

Behavioural advertising cookies: they collect information about the preferences and personal choices of the user (retargeting) to allow the most efficient management possible of the advertising spaces that, where appropriate, the editor has included in a web page, application or platform from which the requested service is provided.

Social cookies: they are set by the social media platforms on the services to allow you to share content with your friends and networks. Social media platforms have the ability to track your online activity outside of the Services. This can affect the content and messages that you see on other services that you visit.

Affiliate cookies: they allow you to track visits from other websites, with which the website establishes an affiliation contract (affiliate companies).

Security cookies: they store encrypted information to prevent the data stored in them from being vulnerable to malicious attacks from third parties. They are used only on HTTPS connections.

ACCORDING TO THE PROPERTY

Own cookies: those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain managed by the editor itself and from which the service requested by the user is provided.

Third-party cookies: those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the publisher, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through cookies.

ACCORDING TO THE CONSERVATION PERIOD

Session cookies: a type of cookies designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a web page.

Persistent cookies: a type of cookies in which the data is still stored in the terminal and can be accessed and processed during a period defined by the person responsible for the cookie, which can range from a few minutes to several years.



PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

- Right to file a claim with the Control Authority (www.aepd.es) if you consider that the treatment does not comply with current regulations.

1. Click Settings.
2. Click Show Advanced Options.
3. In the "Privacy" section, click on Content settings.
 - Delete cookies: Click on All cookies and site data ...
 - Do not allow cookies to be stored.
4. Click Clear browsing data (empty Cache).
5. Close and restart the browser.

Select Tools | Internet Options.

1. Click the General tab.
